

I. Participation live on site:



The live auction at Sotheby's in the Palais Oppenheim, Gustav-Heinemann-Ufer 136-138, 50968 Cologne, Germany, starts at 5:00 p.m. (CET) on 05.10.2023. Admission is from 3:30 p.m.

To participate on site, a registration is required latest by 28 September 2023 at **www.desideria.org/charityartauction**. Please note that the number of places is limited. Places will be allocated in the order of registration. An early registration is therefore recommended.

2. Participation and bidding during the live stream:



The auction will be broadcasted via live stream on the internet. So you can also bid without being on site, by written bid, over the phone or via WhatsApp.

You will find the link to the live stream on the day of the auction, 05.10.2023, at **www.desideria.org/benefizauktion**. Please note: there may be time delays in the transmission of the live stream.

Telephone bids: Send us the completed purchase order. Please state the lot number of the works you wish to bid on. The lot number can be found in the catalogue under the work and before the artist's name. We will ring you shortly before your lot is called in the auction. You can then bid live on the phone as if you were there.

WhatsApp bids: Send us the completed purchase order. Please state your mobile phone number in it. You do not have to indicate the lot numbers you wish to bid on. You can then bid live in the WhatsApp chat on 05.10.2023 from 17:00 as if you were on site. We will contact you with details shortly before the auction.

Written bids: Send us the completed purchase order. Your maximum bid / purchase limit is the highest amount you are willing to pay for a lot. The maximum bid you submit must be at least the amount of the starting bid (see catalogue). It will only be used up to the extent necessary to outbid all other bidders.
